TROTTIN' THROUGH HISTORY



A team with a career record of 19,668-332 could not be considered anything less than extraordinary. One of the oldest and most recognized teams in the country, the Harlem Globetrotters have certainly made a name for themselves through their on-court antics and astounding skill. What is less known, however, is the team's seven decade-long impact on the history of basketball.

The Globetrotters were instrumental in the development of the fast-break offense, the slam dunk, the development of a scouting system to recruit players, and the introduction of the figure-eight "weave" offense. Recently, they have set world records in the vertical slam dunk, reaching a height of 12 feet.

Since the team's formation in 1927, the Globetrotters have played before more people, in more places than any team in sports history. They celebrated a milestone in 1998 – their 72nd consecutive season – when they played their unprecedented 20 thousandth career game. This extraordinary accomplishment did not go unnoticed. Bill Clinton hailed it as "a testament to the enduring place you hold not only in sports history, but also in the hearts of your fellow Americans."
